Verbal abuse degrade, threaten, cursing 7 Sexual abuse inappropriate touch, exposing oneself, sexually oriented conversations Mental abuse: shaming, humiliation, cruelty Neglect: unreasonably withholding food, water, adequate clothing for conditions, or shelter 16. Shall not allow Minors to engage in hazing, bullying, derogatory name calling, or humiliation.

17. Shall report concerns or complaints about other adults or Minors in accordance with all reporting policies
