

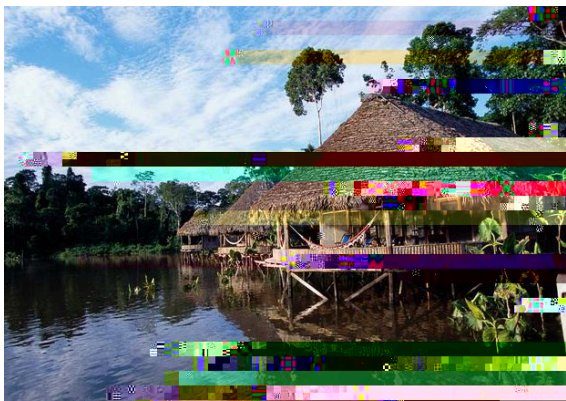

Day 2, Dec 23: Guayaquil



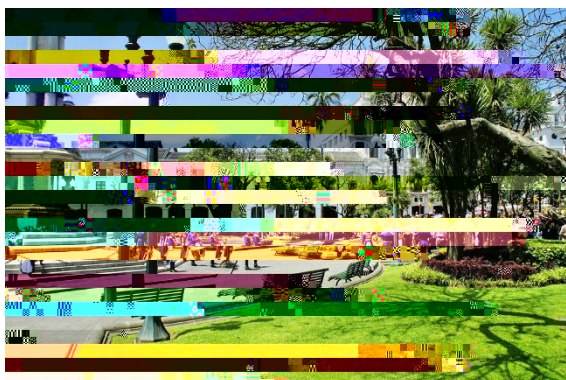
Day 5, Dec 26: Riobamba
