Guidance on Faculty Senate Elections 2018:

1. Elections and election procedures are the responsibility of the units, subject to the Bylaws of the Faculty Senate. Click [here](#) for Faculty Senate Bylaws.
2. The Dean/Director's office is expected to administer the elections. A summary sheet of the senate positions and vacancies specific to each unit has been included with the election memo and attachments.
3. The Dean/Director may not "appoint" anyone to the Faculty Senate; this is the prerogative of the faculty. Ask faculty to nominate other faculty for the open seats.
4. NOT ALL FACULTY AFFILIATED WITH A UNIT MAY PARTICIPATE. The
